Real Estate Financing and Development

- **President of Seaport Village**, an entertainment retailing complex in San Diego
- **Co-founder** of firm that developed Ramada Maingate at Disneyland, a 467-room hotel next to Disneyland, CA;

Internet Commerce

- **Inventor (3 patents), co-founder of First Virtual, Chairman and CEO** at the time of its IPO, developed a secure online payment system, his IP subsequently acquired by eBay/Paypal; and

Entertainment Finance

- **Co-founder of Stein & Stein**, a management and advisory company for high net worth individuals primarily in the entertainment industry.
